Eyrie Pinot Blanc, 2021 \$16*Willamette Valley, Oregon*

From two plots of Pinot Blanc planted in the 1960s and 1990s. Matured on the lees for 11 months. Has pure scents of ripe peach, mushroom powder, jasmine, beeswax and flint. The light-bodied palate is textural and spicy with focused acidity and a long, mineral-driven finish.

Merry Edwards Sauvignon Blanc, 2022 \$24*Russian River Valley, California*

D'Yquem and Musqué Clone. Barrel fermented. Offers pretty aromas of elderflower, white peaches, lime peel and kiwi with touches of baker's yeast and alluring floral perfume. The palate is medium-bodied and flavorful, with notable concentration and freshness.

Domaine Fichet Meursault***Le Meix Sous le Château, 2020*** \$30*Burgundy, France*

A reserved but focused nose that delivers satisfying citrus peel and light thyme aromas. The palate is well-balanced with fine acidity, taut, and fresh with impressive weight and persistence.

Château Pibarnon Bandol Rosé***Nuances, 2021*** \$22*Provence, France*

From the estate's highest and oldest vineyards. 100% Mourvèdre that's aged in oak and terracotta for an additional year. Richly textured and gently steeped strawberry, persimmon, peach and blood orange flavors add to its finely stitched rooibos tea, terra cotta and incense notes. This is rounded through the finish, but has just the right acidity to support it.

Château St Cosme**Châteauneuf-du-Pape, 2019** \$24*Rhône, France*

Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah, and Cinsault. Showcases attractive cooked black fruits, black olives, cured meat, and floral, crushed rose petal lift. Soft tannins are kept in check by bright acidity.

Turley Zinfandel Old Vines, 2021 \$16*California*

A selection of old vine plots that are too small to bottle individually. "Has a medium ruby color and plush red and black cherries on the nose with accents of mushrooms, forest floor, savory spices and mint. The full-bodied palate is grainy and refreshing with generous berry fruit and a long, spicy finish."

Domaine Eden Cabernet**Sauvignon, 2018** \$22*Santa Cruz Mountains, California*

"Dark and brooding... this is a classic Santa Cruz Mountains Cabernet. It offers copious black fruit, dried herbs, chocolate, lavender, and underbrush, all in a super-classic, mid-weight style. This might very well be the best value in artisan, high-end California Cabernet."

Cavalotto Barolo Bricco Boschis, 2018 \$30*Piedmont, Italy*

A powerhouse! A blast of sweet cherry, menthol, licorice, gravel, and incense hits the palate. The wine is streamlined and tight with forest berry, blackcurrant and spice. It is taut and silky, showing fruit that has been shaped by cool nights and warm days.
